# BreastScreening-AI Publishes Recent Achievements and Funding Momentum Update 2026

## Detailed Announcement

- Tecnico Lisboa published coverage on 20 May 2026 stating that BreastScreening-AI secured approximately EUR 500,000 in support through the European Innovation Council Pre-Accelerator pathway.
- ISR-Lisboa published related institutional coverage on 28 April 2026 confirming that BreastScreening-AI had been selected for the EIC Pre-Accelerator.
- The public CORDIS fact sheet for grant agreement 101310071 records an EC signature date of 17 June 2026, a project start date of 1 July 2026, and a net EU contribution of EUR 489,941.62 for the BreastScreening-AI project coordinated by SensiPerception, LDA.
- The current update also links recent momentum to earlier public recognition milestones, including finalist status in the 2024 WIPO Global Awards and selection for the 2024 S3E Start venture-development program.
- Together, these milestones indicate stronger institutional visibility, public funding validation, and a more structured reporting baseline. They do not by themselves establish clinical authorization, customer revenue scale, or unrestricted commercial deployment.

## Investor Relevance

This update consolidates the strongest recent public signals relevant to investor review: European funding validation, public project registration, institutional recognition, and an increasingly structured reporting posture. It is useful as a website-safe momentum summary because the core statements can be tied to named public sources rather than private negotiations or unpublished operating materials.
