## Detailed Announcement

- South3E identified BreastScreening-AI as one of 14 teams selected for the 2024 edition of S3E Start.
- The program supports deep-tech research teams in developing the capabilities required to move innovation from laboratory work toward market preparation.
- The published program profile identified project planning, market preparation, pitching readiness, and preparation for future European funding pathways as relevant outcomes of participation.
- The profile described a research team involving Instituto Superior Tecnico and the University of Coimbra and named Francisco Maria Calisto, Carlos Santiago, and Andre Fadiga as team members.
